Your food waste is collected and taken to the Wastesavers Depot in Newport before being sent to a composting plant where it is turned into soil improver to be used in agriculture.

Food waste recycling

We have provided you with a small food waste caddy and a years supply of compostable liners to help you recycle your food waste.



How do I use my food waste caddy?

1. Line your caddy with the compostable liners or newspaper and fill it with raw and cooked food waste such as vegetable peelings or leftovers. Never use plastics bags.



2. When the caddy is full tie up the liner or roll up the newspaper and drop it off in your onsite brown food waste bin.
3. The brown food waste bin is located near your other recycling bins.
4. The bin will then be emptied **EVERY WEEK** by Wastesavers staff.

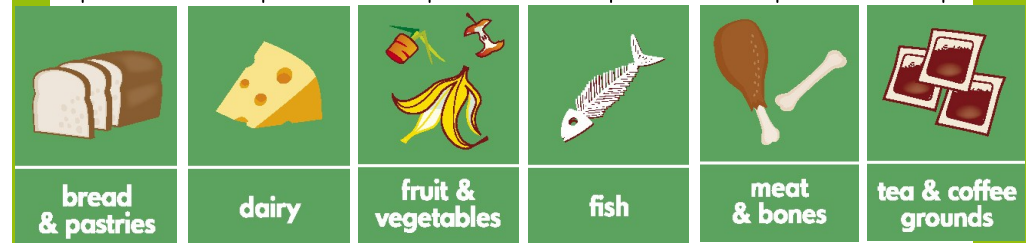
What can I put in my caddy?

Place any raw or cooked food in your caddy. You can even scrape raw or uneaten food straight into your caddy.
