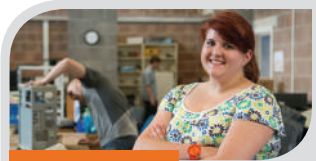




Flats recycling plus Not your average recycling service

We provide opportunities for young people finding it difficult in mainstream education, giving them practical experience and skills ranging from carpentry and bike repair to cooking and plumbing.

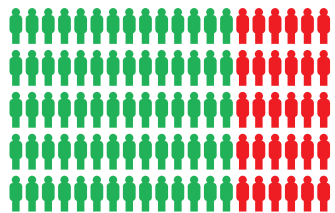

Keeping it simple: Keeping it separate.

Your block has communal recycling facilities that we hope you will use.

You can put your recycling in the bins any day of the week – no need to wait for your collection day.

Please - only put relevant materials in each bin – do not put general rubbish in any recycling bin; we will not be able to take it away.

Food waste: We supply a free five litre food caddy and compostable liners for your kitchen. When full just take the liner down to the communal bin area any time.



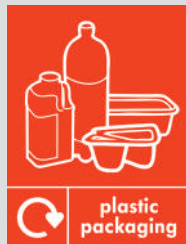
Cardboard

Boxes, packaging, brown card, white card, centre of toilet rolls, greetings/birthday cards.



Food

All food waste including: meat and fish bones and left overs, tea bags, stale bread, fruit and vegetable peelings, dairy products.



Plastic packaging

Milk bottles, yogurt pots, margarine tubs, shampoo bottles, detergent bottles (NO PLASTIC BAGS PLEASE).



Paper

Newspapers, magazines, writing pads, envelopes, shredded paper, junk mail, leaflets and flyers.



Mixed glass

Glass bottles and jars - all colours.



Tins and cans

Drinks cans, food tins, aerosols, clean foil.
